

Amish Built vs Big Box Store Cabinets...can you get you kitchen cabinets cheaper from a big box store?
 Yes!

So...what's the difference? Look below for some similarities and some startling differences.



Both have solid wood face frames, solid wood drawer and door fronts and both look similar once installed. Beware, Looks can be deceiving.



Bog Box Store Cabinets are usually constructed using MDF (particle board) plastic fasteners, glue and tack nails.

Amish made cabinets are built better, stronger and made to last. Solid wood side panels, 3/4" plywood frame and shelving, solid wood bracing and stainless fasteners. Particle board is only used in certain paint related circumstances



Most Big Box Store cabinets only offer a smooth panel for an end cabinet, often a sticker or a thin veneer panel glued onto the side of the mdf cabinet after installation is complete.

Amish Cabinets offer the choice of a flush end panel, 3/4" finished plywood panel or a paneled end in which the side panel is constructed as if it were a door, solid wood, beautiful and very strong.



Amish Cabinets also offer you superior door construction with upgraded, 6-way adjustable quick release hinges and 3/4" plywood shelves faced to match or as an alternative we offer soft close cabinet rollouts to make accessing the items inside easier!
